### Charleston Distance Run Offering Special Military Discount

**Charleston, W.Va., July 19, 2012** — The Charleston Distance Run is looking for a few good men and women. Our bugle call is being sounded for all active military units, including the National Guard, to participate in Distance Run events.

A special U.S. military entry fee of \$20 per person is being offered by the CDR for all events – the 15-mile run, three-person 15-mile relay, 5K run, 5K walk and 10K walk. Mail-in applications for the military discount must be received by Aug. 31. Paper applications also can be submitted in person from 4 p.m. to 9 p.m. Aug. 31 at the Charleston Civic Center. There will be no online registration for the military discount. Paper applications may be printed from the CDR website at **[www.charlestdistancerun.com](http://www.charlestdistancerun.com)**. Proper military identification must be presented to pick up race packets.

“Our military personnel make great sacrifices,” said John Palmer, race director of the Charleston Distance Run. “The Distance Run Committee wanted to offer a special discount to recognize the outstanding contributions of the military and to encourage participation in the CDR’s events.”

The \$20 special U.S. military entry fee offers substantial savings. Regular fees for non-military personnel are as follows: **15-miler** –\$35 by Aug. 1, \$45 by Aug. 22 and \$55 by 9 p.m. Aug. 31; **5K run and three-person 15-mile relay** – \$30 by Aug. 22 and \$40 by 9 p.m. Aug. 31; and **5K and 10K walks** – \$20 by Aug. 22 and \$25 by 9 p.m. Aug. 31.

The Charleston Distance Run is scheduled for 7:30 a.m. Sept. 1 at the West Virginia State Capitol. More information is available at **[www.charlestdistancerun.com](http://www.charlestdistancerun.com)**.
